* Punch Needle Crafting: Tools & Supplies Checklist *

Ready to start punch needle crafting? Here are a few great places to start sourcing out your supplies online.

Punch Needle
[] Oxford Punch Needle (#10 Regular). Find here and here . – Beginner-friendly
and ergonomic. Highly recommended for beginners.
[] Lavor Punch Needle (5.5mm). Find <u>here</u> and <u>here</u> . – Adjustable, also good
for beginners. If in doubt, start with the Oxford (#10 Regular).
Yarn
[] Worsted Weight Yarn (Category 4). Find here and here . Perfect for full
loops.
[] Bulky Yarn (Category 5). Find <u>here</u> and <u>here.</u> For plush, textured loops.
<u>Tip</u> 1: If you have thinner yarn at home, just double it up!
<u>Tip</u> 2: For crafting, most yarns work, from acrylic to wool. If you are inspired
to make a rug, use durable "rug yarn" specifically made for this purpose.
Foundation Fabric
[] Monk's Cloth – Find <u>here</u> and <u>here</u> . Soft, durable, best for beginners.
[] Primitive Linen – Find <u>here</u> and <u>here</u> . Textured, stiffer than Monk's Cloth.
Great once comfortable with Monk's Cloth.
X [] Avoid: Tightly woven fabrics (e.g., "weaver's cloth," denim).
Working Frame or Hoop
[] No-Slip Hoop – Keeps fabric taut: Morgan No-Slip or this set
[] Wood Frames / Stretcher Bars – Find <u>here</u> , to secure fabric and/or frame.

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[] Q-Snap Frames – Find here. Affordable, but expect to retighten often.
